## **Congratulations Award Winners**

We wish to extend our congratulations to graduating students; Clare M., Kate R., and Sofia K. for receiving the [McCall Huron County Scholarship](#) and Emily M., who received the McCall Huron County Finalist Award.

The McCall Huron County Scholarship is renewable each year, up to four years for degree programs and up to three years for diploma programs. Students pursuing degree or applied degree programs receive \$7,000 per year. Students pursuing 2-year or 3-year diploma programs receive \$4,000 per year. Students who study in Ontario at a public college or university more than 300km from their high school receive an additional \$2,000 travel stipend per year. Students who study at an out-of-province public college or university in Canada receive an additional \$4,000 travel stipend per year.

## SHSM Programs @ St. Anne's

Students entering Grade 11 in the 2026–2027 school year who are planning to take Cooperative Education in Grade 11 or Grade 12 are invited to enroll in a Specialist High Skills Major, or SHSM, program at St. Anne's. St. Anne's offers seven SHSM sectors: Agriculture, Arts & Culture, Business, Construction, Health & Wellness, Non-Profit, Education & Child Care, and Sports.

SHSM students have access to a variety of free industry-recognized certifications that enhance resumes and post-secondary applications. Students also have opportunities to participate in free field trips and experiential learning activities related to their sector of interest. ## Dual Credit Courses

St. Anne's partners with 3 local colleges: Conestoga, Fanshawe and Lambton College to deliver a variety of dual credit courses. Upon successful completion of a dual credit course, students earn one high school credit and one college credit at the same time! Students must be at least 16 years of age to enrol in dual credit courses.

### Semester 1

- Conestoga - HVAC - November 10 to Jan. 5 - once a week for 7 weeks
- Lambton - offers a variety of dual credit courses

### Semester 2

- Conestoga - Heavy Equipment - dates to be announced
- Lambton will again offer a variety of courses
