## Opportunity for French Certification through the DELF

St. Anne's and Huron-Perth Catholic District School Board are excited to provide our Grade 12 Core French and French Immersion students with the opportunity to challenge the DELF (Diplôme d'Études en Langue Française) exam again this year. The DELF is an internationally recognized proficiency exam based on The Common European Framework of Reference, which defines language learning across six different levels: A1, A2, B1, B2, C1, and C2. At each level, proficiency is measured in four areas: speaking, listening, reading, and writing. The French Ministry of National Education awards a diploma to successful candidates.

HPCDSB places a high value on second language learning, particularly French, and is committed to encouraging students to pursue their French studies through grade 12, recognizing that second language acquisition enhances mental flexibility and problem-solving skills. The DELF serves as a testimony to an individual's success and accomplishments in their language learning. It acknowledges a learner's personal achievements and progress along their unique path to French proficiency, making it a valuable addition to a student's resumé and a testament to the dedication and hard work invested in learning the language. Learning a second language is a lifelong process that develops pride, a sense of accomplishment, and self-confidence.
