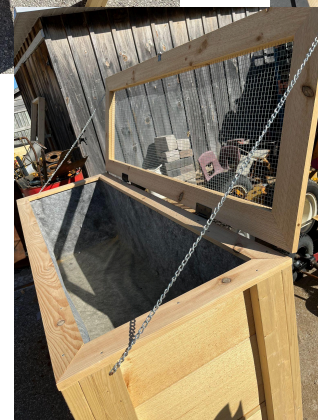
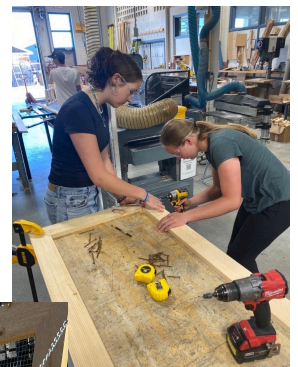
Dear St. Anne's C.S.S. Families,
