### **Semester 2 Report Cards**

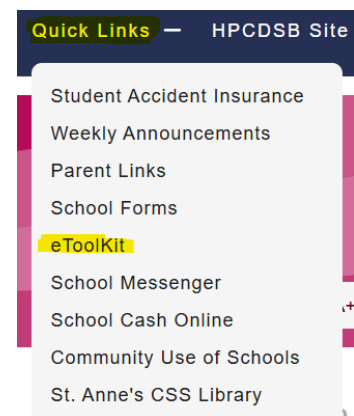
